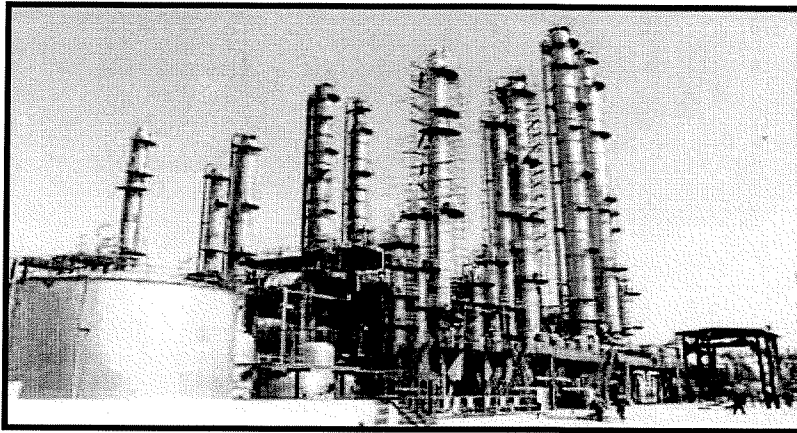

Safety Attendants assist skilled and professional laborers to complete routine maintenance and repair during refinery turnaround season by focusing on safety. Safety Attendant jobs include fire watch, hole watch, bottle watch, and laborer.

- **2 weeks of training**
- **40+ hours of safety training**

Requirements:

- Proof of right to work in the U.S.
- At least 18 years old
- High school diploma or GED
- Valid driver's license
- No misdemeanors or felonies within the last 7 years
- Ability to maintain and adhere to program schedule (includes days/nights and some weekends)
- Able to fulfill the requisites of refinery work:
 - Lift up to 50 lbs.
 - Climb up to a height of 200 ft.
 - Work in confined spaces
- Served in U.S. Military, Naval, Coast Guard or Air service
- National Guard and Reservists who have served on active duty or active duty training
- Received an honorable discharge
- Registered with Selective Service
- Valid Picture ID (i.e. CA Driver's license, Military ID, Passport)
- Copy of your DD-214
- Priority on Recently Separated Veterans
 - Left the military from active duty in the last 4 years (ETS after 1/1/2005)
