Certified Nurse Assistant Training Program

Goodwill, Serving the People of Southern Los Angeles County (SOLAC), provides an 11-week nurse assistant classroom and clinical training program that prepares students to qualify to take the State of California Nursing Assistant examination.



Mentoring assistance is available throughout the duration of the program. Work Readiness and Financial Literacy also are part of the curriculum.

Employment placement services are provided after graduation with additional retention services, including career ladder follow along services for up to 5 years.

Eligibility requirements are:

1. Low-Income or No Income
2. Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
3. At Least 18 Years of Age
4. Must Pass Reading & Math (Literacy assessment at 9th grade level or higher)
5. Complete/Pass Nurse Entrance Interview
6. No Criminal Background (Misdemeanor or Felony)

Goodwill SOLAC currently offers six sessions per year, and space is limited.
