Custodial Technician Training Program

The Custodial Technician Training program was developed by The College & Career Preparation Division at West Los Angeles College to provide students with the knowledge and hands-on training needed to apply for entry-level building maintenance service positions in the public and private sectors. Students will learn and practice basic safety protocols, the use of common custodial tools, and specific cleaning processes for different types of building areas.

CUSTODIAL TECHNICIAN TRAINING PROGRAM CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION

If you are interested in obtaining employment in the cleaning industry, the custodial technician training program is a great way to get started. West L.A. College's Custodial Technician certificate training program will prepare you to work in the custodial field as quickly as possible. The classes are offered for FREE, and are conducted as pass/fail. No credit or grades are given. This is a 60-hour custodial training course and a 36-hour Blueprint for workplace success course. In order to receive a certificate of completion students must attend all scheduled classes.

This program is fast paced and will provide you with the skills and knowledge to work as a custodian in healthcare environment, Schools, and many other industries. Also, you will learn the impact of the Custodian Technician in Facilities Management.



When you successfully complete the training with a "pass," you will receive a Certificate of Completion and job readiness and employment placement assistance from an experienced instructor and coaches.

Student Eligibility and Requirements:

All students are eligible to participate in these FREE, noncredit classes. You will be expected to attend class each and every day, study hard and successfully learn the material.
