GET REFERRED

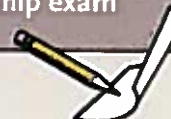
- > Get referred to a Union Apprenticeship training program in one of the 17 Building Trades

- > Start earning right away

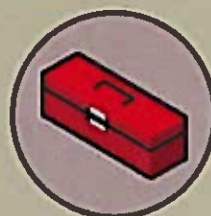

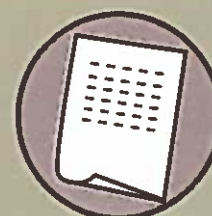
After Certificate of Completion
